We have now been dealing with the coronavirus for over a year. The impact on our lives cannot be ignored or denied. Our world has been assaulted violently by a tiny enemy with a mighty reach. Our only defense for months was isolation, distancing, covering our face, washing and sanitizing our hands raw and prayer. For millions, none of these efforts prevented illness and death. We have been living in between. We are in between our lives before this illness and the world we hope to arrive at after this time of lockdowns, economic crisis, illness and fear. As if that wasn't enough to deal with, our nation has experienced unrest, division, racial and political tension. As if that wasn't enough, our denomination is still also divided on social issues. As if that wasn't more than enough to deal with, life has personally had it's struggles for many of us. Many have experienced illness, death, job loss, and other difficulties.

Living in a time when so many situations are up in the air, it has been a struggle to stay grounded in our faith. We often do not do well living in uncertainty for extended periods of time. I recently attended a virtual seminar and listened to Rev. Susan Beaumont, the author of "How to Lead When You Don't Know Where You're Going: Leading in a Liminal Season". Her book was written and published just before our world pandemic. She offers insights and hope for a time like this and did so without knowing how timely this book would be.

I want to share just a little from her work with you because it helps to acknowledge where we are. We are betwixt and between. "We are in a time of liminality. Liminality is a quality of ambiguity and disorientation that occurs in transitory situations and spaces, when a person or group of people is betwixt and between something that has ended, and a new situation not yet begun. During liminal seasons, we occupy space on both sides of a boundary or threshold. We have one foot rooted in something that is not yet over, while the other foot is planted in a thing not yet defined, something not yet ready to begin. We function with structures, identities and relationships formed by our old experiences, although we know that those structures and processes will not serve us adequately in our present reality or in the future."

During times like this, anxiety rises, we deny our current reality and try to just power through it, relationships change, and we may reject sources that have helped us in the past. We desperately seek a lifeline to the past and may grab hold of a vine that isn't rooted to solid ground.

Yet in times like this, we are assured God is with us. And there are opportunities that come into our lives when we least expect them. New relationships develop even in communities that are altered. The soul of our previous groups may emerge with spontaneous fellowship and connections we missed in "normal" times. Innovation and reinventing our lives and purpose can happen. It is a time when we can focus on what is important and rediscover our mission. Now is a time when we can collectively cultivate new wisdom on what it means to follow Christ and be in community. I pray that we look for our opportunities in the year ahead to be people of God. I pray we hold each other close and keep connected in all the ways we are seeking to. We can't just hold on or tell each other to hang on, we have to ask God to hold us in his arms and carry us through. We are called to extend God's love and care to others. We are also called to ask others to help us when we need comfort and strength. We are not in this alone. This life is sometimes full of problems and traumatic events but life is also full of joy and hope. Find your joy and hope with God and through God's people who always have comfort and care for you. "Keep on asking, and you will receive what you ask for. Keep on seeking, and you will find. Keep on knocking, and the door will be opened to you." (NLT Matthew 7:7) Pastor Donna


